TECHNOLOGY UPDATE

The excitement is building! During our recent Congregational Meeting, we voted to improve our technology to offer both online and in-person worship!

In preparation for on-site worship, the fellowship room is receiving a new coat of paint. We're gathering quotes for new carpeting for the sanctuary and the fellowship room. Most importantly, our tech team has cast a vision for us: a hybrid worship service that is both in-person and Zoom capable.

This is a complex issue, requiring new equipment and advice from technology experts. We began a fund drive to pay for this system update (see page 5) which will include two projectors. Because we must rely on online music and video for our worship services, we need a way to share music inside the sanctuary as well as online -- at the same time.

Pastor's Installation

3 PM SUNDAY, JULY 25

Pastor Judy will be officially installed as our minister on July 25. The service will be both in-person and on Zoom at 3 PM. The Michigan UCC Association will be participating via Zoom. Plan to join us!

This update will protect the beauty of our sanctuary; no visible TVs or screens will be needed! We will simply project onto the white walls on either side of the chancel.

Enhanced worship will unite our online family with our in-person family. Audio and video technology will allow us to use the sanctuary for conferences, concerts, and speakers, opening our doors to people and organizations in the broader Jackson community and beyond.

This project has been planned for almost a decade -- and it's finally becoming a reality!

How can you help? Please give generously. The initial expense for this system is about \$22K. Once installed, we will explore a new part time position called "Music/Tech." This person will craft our online presence and create a beautiful musical experience in our worship.

# Covid-19 Guidelines for In-Person Worship

SAFETY UPDATE

We're so excited to announce our sanctuary will be open for Sunday worship on June 27, 2021! It has been a very long pandemic road, but we have learned so much about keeping one another -- and ourselves -- safe. The following guidelines are meant to promote safety in worship:

- Please email or call the church office to RSVP for worship.
- Please arrive by 10:15 a.m. to be seated by 10:20 a.m.
- Please wear a mask at all times.
- Enter the building at the parking lot (South) entrance.
- Please use hand sanitizer upon entering the building.
- Please continue to be seated at the same place for future services.
- We are not permitted to sing at this time, and live instruments will not be used.
- Please do not shake hands when sharing the Passing of Peace.
- Offering plates will not be passed;
   a collection area will be provided.
- Families may sit together. All others will be expected to socialdistance. The pews will be marked in appropriate places.
- Bulletins will be placed on the pews where seating is allowed.
- Please exit the building at the ramp beside the restrooms.



Weather permitting, we are planning to have coffee hour immediately following worship. We will gather outdoors for snacks and conversation! Individually wrapped baked goods will be available, and chairs will be placed in the parking area near the building.

Prior to our opening Sunday, we will be holding a clean-up day. The sanctuary needs dusting and polishing, and our outdoor areas need some loving care! Please watch for future announcements about this special preparation day!

Please ... be patient and understanding as we explore this unique hybrid worship experience. We will be "Zooming" and meeting together in person ... at the same time! Whenever we try something new, we discover glitches and hiccups we didn't anticipate. Let's keep focused on Philippians 4:8-9:

- \$780 was received in April through Givelify

- The Office Administrator position has been advertised on Indeed

- The Church Constitution team will review sample UCC constitutions and bylaws provided by Pastor Judy
- The UCC General Synod will be July 11-18. Pastor Judy would like to attend.





## Technology Fund Drive

WE'RE ALMOST THERE!

During the recent Congregational Meeting the church overwhelmingly offered their support for the new technology upgrades. The original fund for technology was started by the Schroeder's more than 10 years ago. An additional pledge brought the total to \$6,647.

At the end of the congregational meeting we launched the fundraising effort by members pledging over \$7,000 more to the campaign. We are just over \$8,000 away from fully funding this effort!
