I am overwhelmed with thankfulness for our faith family here at St. John's United Church of Christ!

Because of the love, patience and compassion shown by this congregation, I was able to spend time with my father during his last days. My incredible church family allowed me to participate on July 18 via Zoom. I preached a sermon standing in the upstairs hallway of my parents' home in Paw Paw, Michigan! I was blessed by each of you, whether on Zoom or in person, who joined together to worship. It was a unique experience, which allowed me to worship with you and remain close to my dad.

When he passed away during the early hours of July 21, I was there. Thanks to the Pastoral Relations Team, St. John's had a plan in place. While I grieved with my family, St. John's enjoyed uninterrupted spiritual care.

I learned so much during my dad's transition to eternal life! I learned that I am stronger than I thought. I learned how it feels to be completely supported and surrounded by loving friends, family and neighbors. I learned that the stories of our lives are priceless, and when we share our stories, our love for one another grows.

I gained new understanding of the women who went to the tomb of Jesus when dawn was breaking that first Easter morn. I learned how meaningful it is to wash the body of the one you have loved, to choose the clothes and hold his hand one more time. I know now why the women went at first light, with spices and cloths to care for the body of the One they loved.

When we find ourselves faced with the difficult moments of life, I have found it best to ask, "What have you come to teach me?" My father's final days, his final moments, have enriched me in ways I could not have foreseen.

Thank you all for allowing me time to spend with Dad and time to grieve. Thank you for floral arrangements, a tree planted in California where the wildfires burned, a delivery of soup, many cards, calls, text messages and visits, and of course your thoughts and prayers for me and my family.

St. John's has an endearing history. Many families have attended for generations, and those families have provided countless resources to ensure that our family of faith will continue. We want to honor that history!


