Thank you to all who donated sock to our **Save a Sole** mission project. The socks will soon be distributed to those in need.





Happy Re-Birthday!






Lent Book Study Continues

Nancy Hackworth Literacy Update

The Nancy Hackworth Literacy Initiative (NHL) was started by the Hackworth family to honor Nancy Hackworth who dedicated her life to serving the community and the church. Her husband Darryl and son Andy brainstormed ideas on how to honor her. They decided to launch a reading tutoring program and library because it would have lasting impact. Their idea was met with open arms and tons of support by Pastor Judy and Bert Steck who runs the administrative side of operations.

The first tutor who joined the initiative was Susan Nawrot. Sue helped set the standard for the tutoring aspect of the initiative. Then Cindy Osbourne joined the initiative. With her years of bookstore experience, Cindy pulled the library together, making it what Darryl always envisioned. Kellie Hubbard, Jeff Wilkinson, Bette Watkins, and Cindy Spiess are the current tutors for the students. So far, students have benefited from 450 tutoring sessions.

The NHL offers reading tutoring to students, story-time sessions, as well as a library located inside the church that has almost 100 books to choose from. The NHL needs help expanding its reach to children who are connected to members of the church. It is free and open to all members and children of the community.
